Background of our school

- 1. Our school is SKH Tin Shui Wai Ling Oi Primary School
- 2. We have 3 classes of P.3 students
- 3. Every class was formed by mixed ability students
- 4. Students do not have a rich English language environment

What do we do this year?

- We were invited to join the SA pilot scheme.

Why did we join this scheme?

- It is an additional assessment tool.
- We can conduct this assessment according to students' needs and learning progress.
- We can find out the strengths and weaknesses of students in order to improve learning and teaching

Pre-test

- We chose three text types and EASD (Education Assessment Services Division) helped us to create a pre-test for our students in December.
- After doing the pre-test, the officer of EASD came to have a meeting to discuss the result of the pre-test.
- We highlighted the strengths and the weaknesses of our students.

Class report

The report can show

- the percentage of correctness of each question
- which options students chose
- the percentage of each option that students chose
- the ranking of the students
- what's the possible problem of the wrong decision
- can save the record in excel to make modification and comparison

How we made use of the report

- Step 1: Analyze students' weaknesses
- Teachers found out the performance of each student
- Teachers discussed which type of questions that students were weak in with the officer from EASD
- We found that students were weak in pronouns referencing skill (The mean of correct percentage: 31%)

Some students mixed up the meaning of 'outside' and 'inside'.

3. Read line 6. What does 'it' refer to? (pronoun references)

A challenging item, 'weather' would be a very strong distracter for students because that word is just next to the pronoun 'it'. It may need to emphasis that 'the sun' is the main idea of the poem.

Step 2: Adjust teaching strategies

- Spent more time on discussing the questions that students were weak in. Teachers asked students questions about pronouns
- Used the resources that were given by EASD which is web-based learning

How we made use of the report

- Teachers designed the booklets based on the texttype that students were weak in.
- 2012-2013 P.3 booklet notice
- 2012-2013 P.3 booklet stories
- Teachers found out those questions which most of the students could not get the correct answers and tried to think of the reasons.
- Teachers taught students that particular reading skill through the discussion of booklet.

Post Test

- Students were assigned another test with 3 different text- types in April and June.
- Tried to choose the text types with similar reading load of pre-test.
- Tried to find the exercise with similar level of difficulties

Improvement on Learning

- Students were exposed to different text-types.
- Students could tell how they find the answers when doing exercises.
 - 2012-2013 booklet postcards, emails, letters
- Improvement is shown in the correct percentage.
- The average of the correct percentage has increased 12-20%
