

Tapescript

Narrator: Part 1A
Miss Wong and P. 3C are going to have a picnic. They are talking about where to go and what to do.
Listen to what they say. The CD will be played two times.
When you hear a beep (*beep*), answer the question(s).
You have 15 seconds to read this part. (*15-second music*)
The CD will begin now.

- [Miss Wong: Good morning, class! We're going for a picnic next month.
- Children: Wow, that's great! (*happy tone*)
- Narrator: Question 1 - How do the children feel? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)
- Miss Wong: P. 3B is going to Ocean Park. Do you want to join them?
- Mike: No, I want to go somewhere else.
- Miss Wong: Where do you want to go, Mike?
- Mike: We can go to the Peak. We can see the beautiful view of Hong Kong.
- Narrator: Question 2 - Where does Mike want to go? What can the children do there? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)
- Miss Wong: OK, Mike. Does anybody have other suggestions? What about you, Peter?
- Peter: How about going to Hong Kong Park? We can see birds and flowers there.
- Miss Wong: That's a good idea, Peter.
- Narrator: Question 3 - Where does Peter want to go? What can the children do there? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 10 seconds*)
- Miss Wong: Lucy, where do you want to go?

Lucy: Let's go to Clear Water Bay. We can go to the beach and build sand castles.

Mike: Wow, great idea! Can we go swimming, too?

Lucy: Oh, no! We are not allowed to swim.

Narrator: Question 4 - Where does Lucy want to go? What can the children do there? // *(beep)(a pause of 10 seconds)*

Miss Wong: That's right! You are too young. You can't go swimming and you can't have a barbecue.

Mike: Oh! What a pity! *(sad tone, slow pace)*

Narrator: Question 5 - How does Mike feel? // *(beep)(a pause of 5 seconds)*]

Listen to the CD again and check your answers. < Repeat [] >
You now have 30 seconds to check your answers. *(30-second pause) (beep)*

Narrator: Part 1B

After the picnic, one of the students, Kitty, goes home. She talks with her mother about a photo of the picnic.

Listen to what Kitty and her mother say. The CD will be played two times. When you hear a beep (*beep*), write the correct name(s) in the box(es). Follow the example.

You have 15 seconds to read this part. (*15-second music*)

The CD will begin now.

Here is an example.

- [Mum: You look very smart in this photo, Kitty. Your cap looks really nice.
- Kitty: Yes. My friends said that I looked smart, too. (*Kitty speaks proudly and happily*) // (*a pause of 5 seconds*)
- Mum: There're two girls next to you. Who are they?
- Kitty: Mary and Jenny (*slow*). Mary is very lucky. She caught a lot of fish that day. (*beep*) (*a pause of 5 seconds*) Jenny did not catch any fish but she was still happy. // (*beep*) (*a pause of 5 seconds*)
- Mum: I see. Is this Tim (*slow*)? His T-shirt looks good.
- Kitty: Yes, it is. His T-shirt has a toy car on it. The wheels can move. // (*beep*) (*a pause of 5 seconds*)
- Mum: Who's the boy holding a football and a bag (*slow*)?
- Kitty: He's my best friend, Sam (*pause*). He likes ball games. // (*beep*) (*a pause of 5 seconds*)
- Mum: There're two girls in the back row. They look the same. Who are they?
- Kitty: Sue and Sandy (*slow*). They're twins. They both have long straight hair but Sue wears glasses (*slow*). // (*beep*) (*a pause of 10 seconds*)
- Mum: And who are these two young ladies?

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Listening –Photo
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Kitty: Oh, they're my teachers, Miss Wong and Miss Chan. Miss Wong is wearing a big hat but Miss Chan is holding an umbrella. // *(beep)* *(a pause of 10 seconds)*

Mum: How about this young man holding a basketball?

Kitty: He's my P.E. teacher, Mr Lam. He likes playing ball games with us.]
// *(beep)* *(a pause of 5 seconds)*

Narrator: Listen to the CD again and check your answers. < Repeat [] >
You now have 30 seconds to check your answers. *(30-second pause)*
(beep)
