

Tapescript

Narrator: Part 1A
Miss Wong and P. 3C are going to have a picnic. They are talking about where to go and what to do.
Listen to what they say. The CD will be played two times.
When you hear a beep (*beep*), answer the question(s).
You have 15 seconds to read this part. (*15-second music*)
The CD will begin now.

[Miss Wong: Good morning, class! We're going for a picnic next month.

Children: Wow, that's great! (*happy tone*)

Narrator: Question 1 - How do the children feel? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)

Miss Wong: P. 3B is going to Ocean Park. Do you want to join them?

Mike: No, I want to go somewhere else.

Miss Wong: Where do you want to go, Mike?

Mike: We can go to the Peak. We can see the beautiful view of Hong Kong.

Narrator: Question 2 - Where does Mike want to go? What can the children do there? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)

Miss Wong: OK, Mike. Does anybody have other suggestions? What about you, Peter?

Peter: How about going to Hong Kong Park? We can see birds and flowers there.

Miss Wong: That's a good idea, Peter.

Narrator: Question 3 - Where does Peter want to go? What can the children do there? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 10 seconds*)

Miss Wong: Lucy, where do you want to go?

Lucy: Let's go to Clear Water Bay. We can go to the beach and build sand castles.

Mike: Wow, great idea! Can we go swimming, too?

Lucy: Oh, no! We are not allowed to swim.

Narrator: Question 4 - Where does Lucy want to go? What can the children do there? // *(beep)(a pause of 10 seconds)*

Miss Wong: That's right! You are too young. You can't go swimming and you can't have a barbecue.

Mike: Oh! What a pity! *(sad tone, slow pace)*

Narrator: Question 5 - How does Mike feel? // *(beep)(a pause of 5 seconds)*]

Listen to the CD again and check your answers. < Repeat [] >
You now have 30 seconds to check your answers. *(30-second pause) (beep)*

Narrator: Part 1B
At the picnic, one of the students, Kitty, lost her purse. She is telling a policeman about it.
Listen to what Kitty and the policeman say. Help the policeman complete the Lost Item Report Form. The CD will be played two times. When you hear a beep (*beep*), answer the questions.
You have 15 seconds to read this part. (*15-second music*)
The CD will begin now.

Kitty: Excuse me, sir.

Policeman: Yes. What can I do for you?

Kitty: I've just lost my purse here. Have you seen a small purse?
(*sad tone*)

Narrator: How does Kitty feel? // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)

Policeman: Well, what's your name?

Kitty: Kitty Wong.

Policeman: OK, Kitty Wong W-O-N-G. // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)
What school do you go to?

Kitty: ABC Primary School.

Policeman: OK, what class are you in?

Kitty: 3C. // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*)

Policeman: And what's your phone number?

Kitty: Seven-two-five-three (*pause*) four-nine-one-eight.

Policeman: 7253 4918. (*slowly*) // (*beep*)(*a pause of 5 seconds*) What colour is your purse?

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Listening - Lost item report form
As at 30 October 2003

- Kitty: Red and blue.
- Policeman: Red and blue. // (beep)(a pause of 10 seconds) OK. When did you last see your purse?
- Kitty: I had it with me when I was at the food stall. // (beep)(a pause of 5 seconds)
- Policeman: I see. What time were you there?
- Kitty: About 4:15 pm.
- Policeman: OK. I will write that down. 4:15 pm. // (beep)(a pause of 5 seconds)
- Kitty: Yes. That's right.
- Policeman: Kitty, what did you have in your purse?
- Kitty: Let me think... my student card and some money. // (beep)(a pause of 10 seconds)
- Policeman: Anything else?
- Kitty: Oh, yes – a photo of my mum, dad and me. // (beep)(a pause of 5 seconds)
- Policeman: Alright. A student card, some money and a family photo in your purse. If we find your purse, we'll call you.

- Narrator: What does Kitty say to the policeman?
- A. Thanks a lot? (*puzzled*)
 - B. Thanks a lot! (*angry*)
 - C. Thanks a lot. (*sad*)
- } voice only]

// (beep)(a pause of 5 seconds)

Listen to the CD again and check your answers. < Repeat [] >
You now have 30 seconds to check your answers. (30-second pause) (beep)
