Miss Lee:	Peter did not know what to do. He took the handbag home and showed it to his mother. She said, "Good boy, Peter! Now, let's take the handbag to the police station." (<i>happy tone</i>)
Narrator:	No. 4: Peter showed the handbag to (<i>beep</i>) (8-second pause) You now have 10 seconds to read Questions 5 to 7. (<i>10-second music</i>) Listen to the last part of the story.
Miss Lee:	After two weeks, the police phoned Peter. They gave him a thank-you letter because he was honest. Peter was very happy. His mother was proud of him.]
Narrator:	 No. 5: The police called Peter after (beep) (8-second pause) No. 6: What did Peter get from the police? (beep) (8-second pause) No. 7: How did Peter's mother feel at the end of the story? (beep) (8-second pause)
	Listen to the story about Peter again and check your answers. The story will begin now. Repeat [] without pauses and questions.
