

Narrator: **Part 3**

*Sam is asking his uncle to fill in a library form.*

Listen to the conversation. The conversation will be played two times. When you hear a beep (*beep*), answer the question or questions. You now have 15 seconds to read the questions below. (*15-second music*) Listen to the conversation.

[Sam: Uncle John, would you please fill in this library form for me?

Uncle: Yes, sure. First we must write your full name.

Sam: (*Playful*) That's easy. It's Sam Lo. (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)

Uncle: Okay. What's the name of your school?

Sam: Hong Kong Primary School.

Uncle: Which level are you in, Sam? Primary 1 or Primary 2?

Sam: No, I'm not in Primary 1 or Primary 2. I'm in Primary 3. (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)

Uncle: How about your date of birth?

Sam: Hmm.

Uncle: When were you born?

Sam: Oh! I never forget that. I was born on the twenty-second of May, nineteen ninety-eight.

Uncle: Twenty-second of May, nineteen ninety-eight. Good. I was born on the twenty-first of May.

Sam: Really?

Uncle: Yes. (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)

Uncle: Now, your home address.

Sam: I live in Room 202, on the 20<sup>th</sup> floor. (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)

Uncle: Does the building have a name, Sam?

Sam: Yes, Happy House. It is on Green Street, Number 18.

Uncle: Right. Happy House at Number 18, Green Street. (*beep*) (*16-second pause*)

Uncle: Now we need to write your parent's name and phone number.

Sam: Mandy Lam, and her number is eight-two-seven-six, five-six-zero-six.

Uncle: Mandy Lam, eight-two-seven-six, five-six-zero-six. (*beep*) (*16-second pause*)  
Okay, finished.

Sam: Thanks, Uncle John.

Uncle: You're welcome, Sam.]

Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The conversation will begin now.

**Repeat [ ] without pause.**
