You now have 2 minutes to answer the questions in Part A and read the questions in Part B. (music 2 mins.) Listen to the conversation between Tom the tour guide, Ms. Wong the teacher and her students. The conversation will be played twice. Do as much as you can the first time and answer all questions the second time. The listening will begin now. [Tour Guide – Tom Good morning everyone. My name is Tom and I am the Head Tour Guide. Welcome to the Hong Kong Wild Animal Zoo. Today you are going on a tour of the zoo that will take you through different environments. PAUSE 1 sec There are some important rules you must follow. Please listen carefully. Do not get out of the vehicle at any time until the tour comes to an end! Do not feed the animals or try to touch them! Always follow instructions on the bus, boat or train! Over to you Ms. Wong. PAUSE 2 secs **Teacher – Ms. Wong** Don't forget to put on your name tags. Your name tag has your group number on it. Now get into your three groups please! PAUSE 1 sec Group one will visit The Plains first, followed by The Jungle. Then you will have lunch in The Jungle and a Meet the Keeper session. The day will end at The Water area. the mosquitoes!

Teacher – Ms. Wong	Don't worry Peter. There aren't that many mosquitoes here.
	PAUSE 1 sec
	Group two will start in The Jungle. You will then visit The Water area and have lunch on the riverbank. After lunch you will have a Meet the Keeper session, and then travel to The Plains area.
Student 2 – Nelly	( <i>afraid</i> ) If we have lunch on the riverbank, won't we get eaten by the crocodiles?
	PAUSE 2 secs
Teacher – Ms. Wong	Don't be afraid Nelly! The crocodiles have already been fed! Besides, we won't be eating anywhere near them!
	PAUSE 1 sec
	Now, group three will start in The Water area, followed by a visit to The Plains. You will have lunch and your Meet the Keeper session in the tree house. The day will end in The Jungle area.
	You must all meet back here at the main gate at 3:30 p.m. to board the bus!
	PAUSE 2 secs
Tour Guide – Tom	So, does anyone have any questions before the tour starts?
Student 1 – Peter	I do. What animals will we see on The Plains? Are they dangerous?
Tour Guide – Tom	On The Plains we have elephants, giraffes and lions. All wild animals are dangerous.
Student 2 – Nelly	Are there many dangerous animals in The Jungle? Will we see wolves and tigers?
Tour Guide – Tom	You will see tigers, but no wolves. You may also see monkeys and snakes. The tigers and snakes are dangerous.

Student 3 – Alex (male)	Cool! Are there any dangerous animals in The Water area?
Tour Guide – Tom	How about a shark and a hippopotamus Alex? You will also get to see some seals.
Student 3 – Alex	Ooh a shark! What kind of shark I wonder – a man-eater like the Great White? <i>fade out</i> ]
Narrator	Now listen to the conversation again. {Repeat []}
Narrator	You have 30 seconds to check your answers. (music 30 secs.)
