**Tina - Student**                Everyone is ready to report on the choices you gave us the last time. Some members can't make it today. There are music exams and an OLE outing to the new theme park. I'll take notes so they get an idea of what we talked about. This can help us decide where we are going.

**Tina - Student**                Oh yes, I saw you turn on your recording app. That's a great idea. Thanks Mr. Lau. I'll be able to check the recording if I miss anything while I am taking notes!

**Mark - Student**                I checked the website and found out that we have to make a booking. They have a limit to the number of people in a group.

- Candy - employee of the HK Butterfly Reserve (female voice)** Good afternoon. Hong Kong Butterfly Reserve, Candy speaking. How may I help you?
- Mark - Student** Hi Candy, it's Mark from FRKLSSTSS Secondary School. We are planning a field trip to the reserve with students from the Geography Club. On the website the price listed was \$50 per person. Do you have a student discount?
- Candy - employee of the HK Butterfly Reserve (female voice)** Hi Mark. Yes, we have student and group discounts. Students get a 50% discount. Student tickets are 25 dollars. We also have group and school discounts, depending on how many people there are. The group discount is 10% off the normal ticket price. School discounts depend on the number of students.
- Mark - Student** Oh, I don't have an exact number yet, Candy.
- Candy - employee of the HK Butterfly Reserve (female voice)** That's OK Mark. Call us when you have more information. Is there anything else?
- Mark - Student** No, that's all Candy. Thanks. I will call you when we know how many

students will be going. Bye.
