Narrator

(door opening and closing)

Mrs. Pang – Music teacher and Music Club advisor Sorry I'm late everyone. I'm assuming that Eva knows about the K-POP rehearsal at school – seeing as she's still on the floor.

Ben – Music Club Head (laughing) Oh yes Mrs. Pang. Eva knows.

Mrs. Pang – Music teacher and Music Club advisor So, what Ben hasn't told you is that this rehearsal is the only one that the bands are doing before the festival starts. RSB has some new music and dance moves they want to try out in front of a real audience. This is a great opportunity for them to get a reaction from their fans.

Eva – Music Club member (excited) Oh wow, this is just fantastic! Do you think we'll get to meet them Mrs. Pang? Oh, I would love to meet the members of RSB, Yang, Lee Kim, Soong and Bang.

RSB is the boy band that won the Artist of the Year award at the Melba Music Awards.

Oh, and SGB! I'd love to meet the girls, May, Luna, Vicki and Baby P and ask them about their costumes – they always look so wonderful.

Mrs. Pang – Music teacher and Music Club advisor Eva, slow down and calm down. We'll talk about all of that later.
