(10-second pause)

Mary: A big family? How many brothers and sisters does Angela have?

Miss Wong: She has 3 brothers and 5 sisters. She is the oldest girl in the family. // (beep)

(5-second pause)

When Angela was small, she did not go to school. Every morning, she went to a

bookshop and did the cleaning. // (beep) (5-second pause)

John: But how did she learn to be a writer?

Miss Wong: Angela wanted to read books, but she didn't know how. A shopkeeper in the

bookshop was very nice. He taught Angela how to read and write. Angela loved reading very much. She read a lot of books. After reading many storybooks, she tried to write her own stories. Many people like to read her books. She is now a

famous writer.// (beep) (15-second pause)

Mary: How old was Angela when she wrote her first story?

Miss Wong: Can you guess?

John: 15 years old?

Miss Wong: No, younger than that.

Mary: 11 years old?

Miss Wong: Haha... Believe it or not, she wrote her first story when she was only nine years

old. // (beep) (5-second pause)

John: Wow! Angela is really great!]
