Narrator: Question 4. Where will John buy food for the picnic? // (beep) (5-second pause)

Mary: What games do you want to play on the picnic day?

John: Let me think... I like ball games.

Mary: OK. I know what to bring.

Narrator: Question 5. What will Mary bring to play with on the picnic day? // (beep)

(5-second pause)

Mary: Here's my stop. I have to get off now. See you tomorrow. Bye.

John: Bye.

Narrator: Question 6. Where are the children when they are talking to each other? // (beep)

(5-second pause)]
