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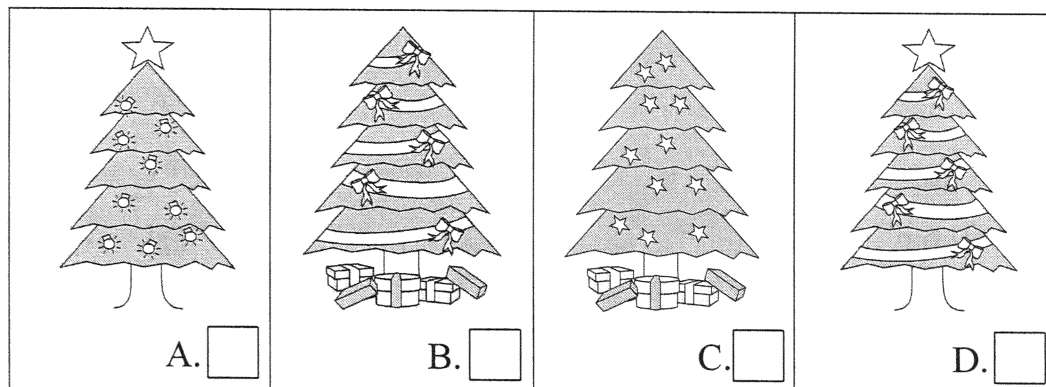
1. Which one is Mary's gift?

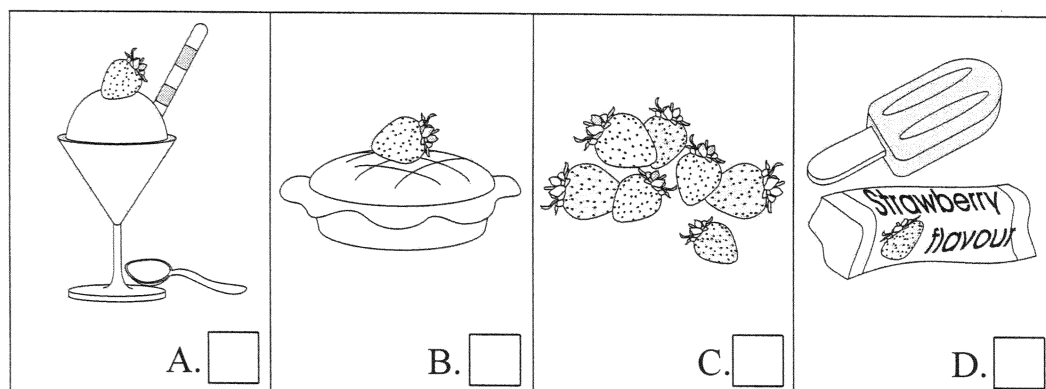
2. Which one is Winnie's Christmas tree?

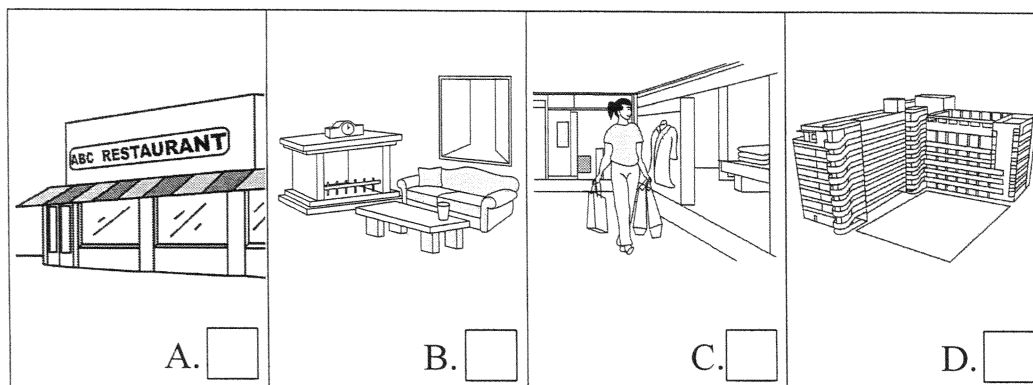

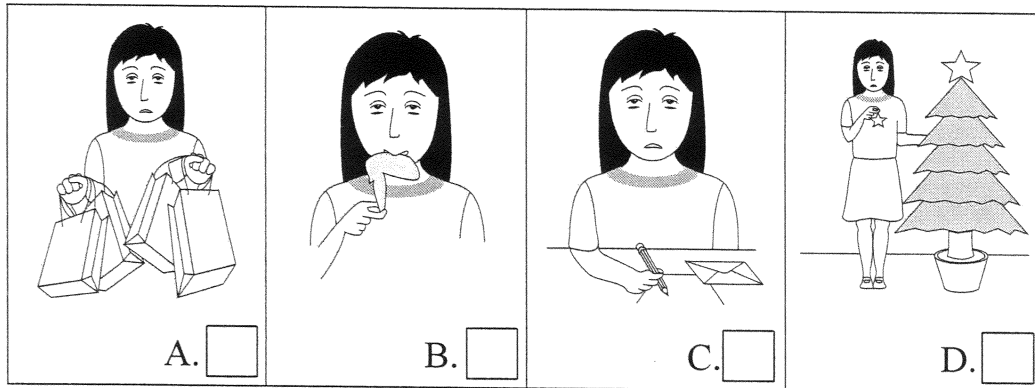

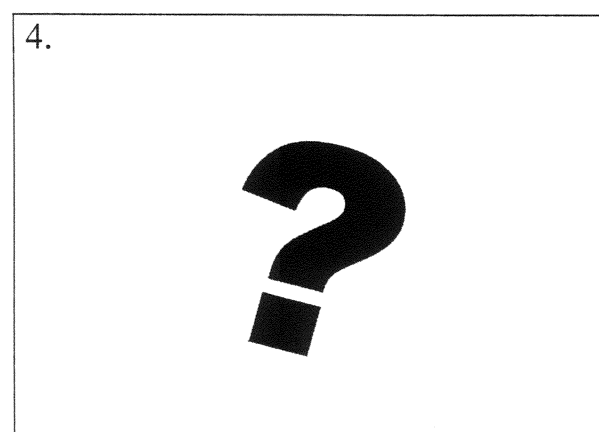
