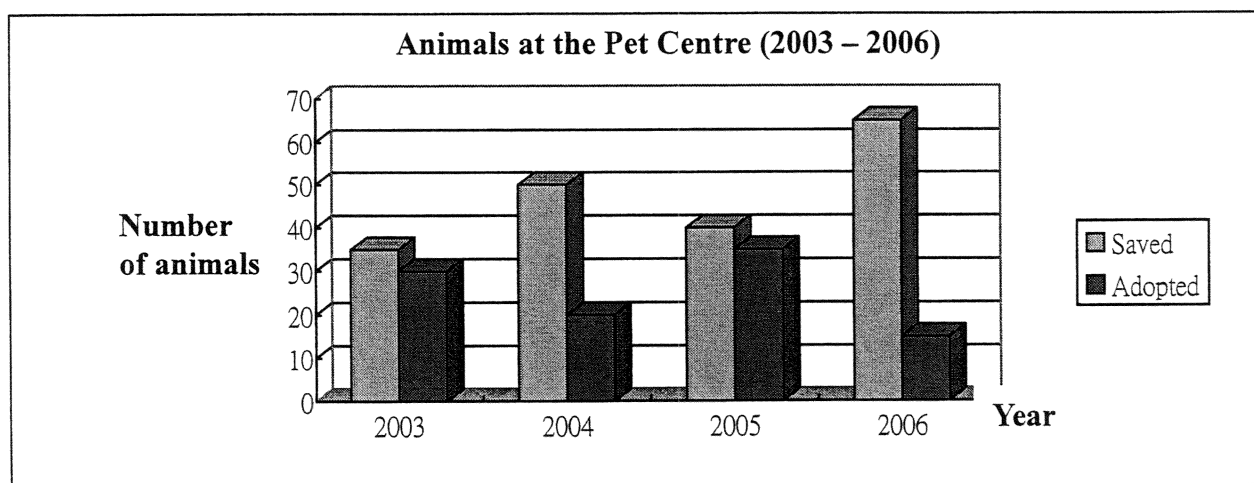

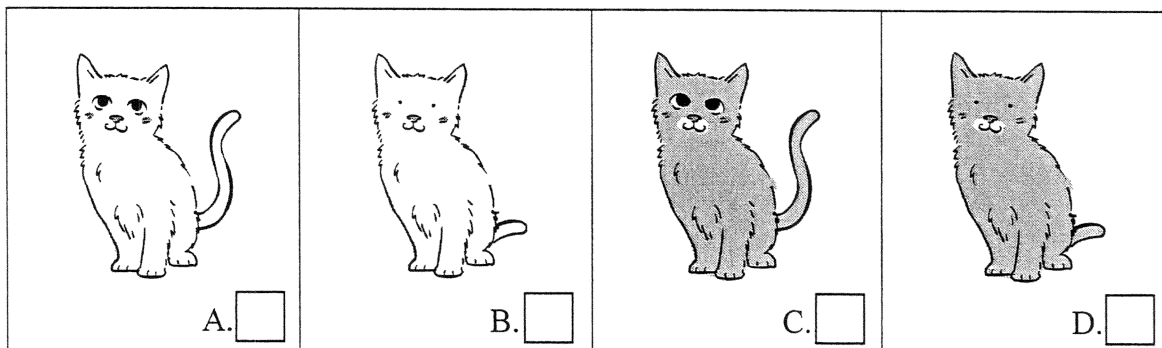

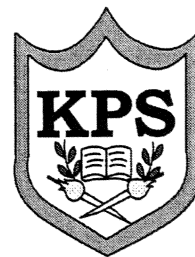

“Yes, and it hurts a lot. Do I need to see a doctor?”

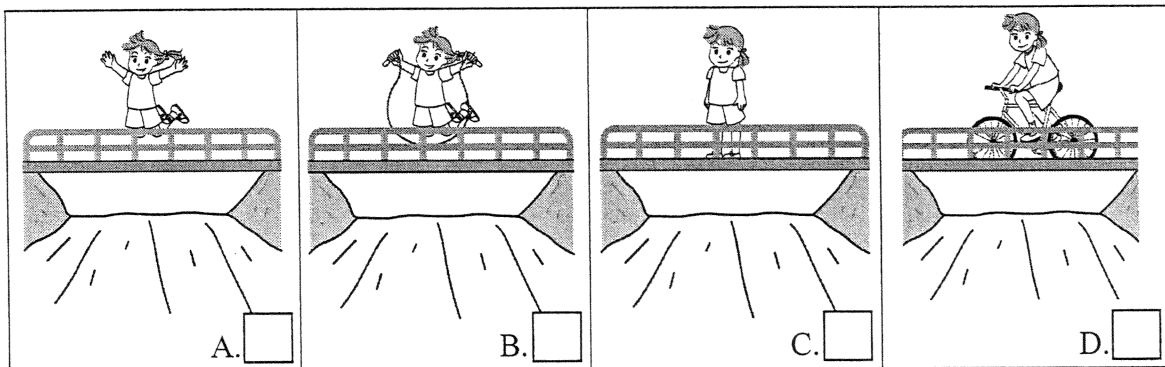
“Yes, but let me put some medicine and a bandage on your hand first.”

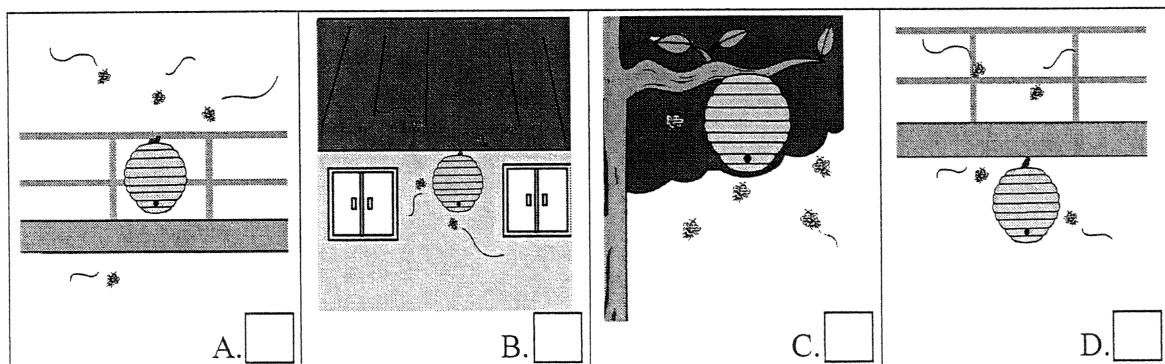

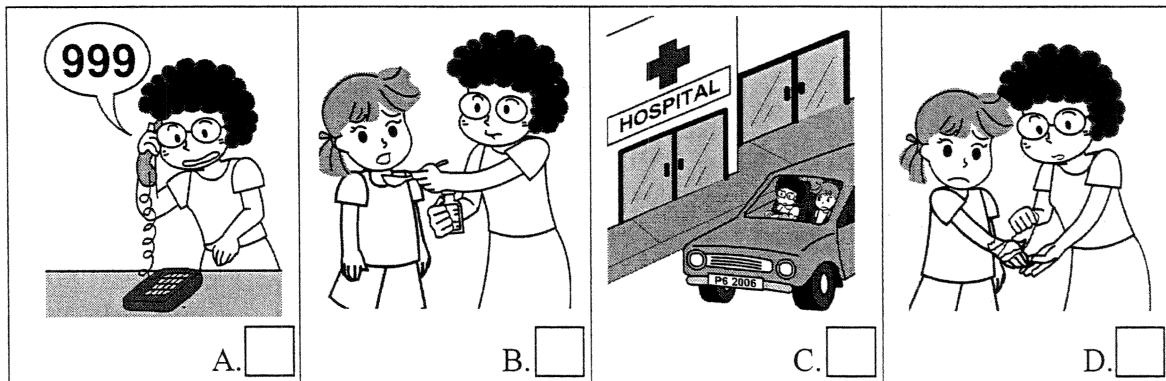

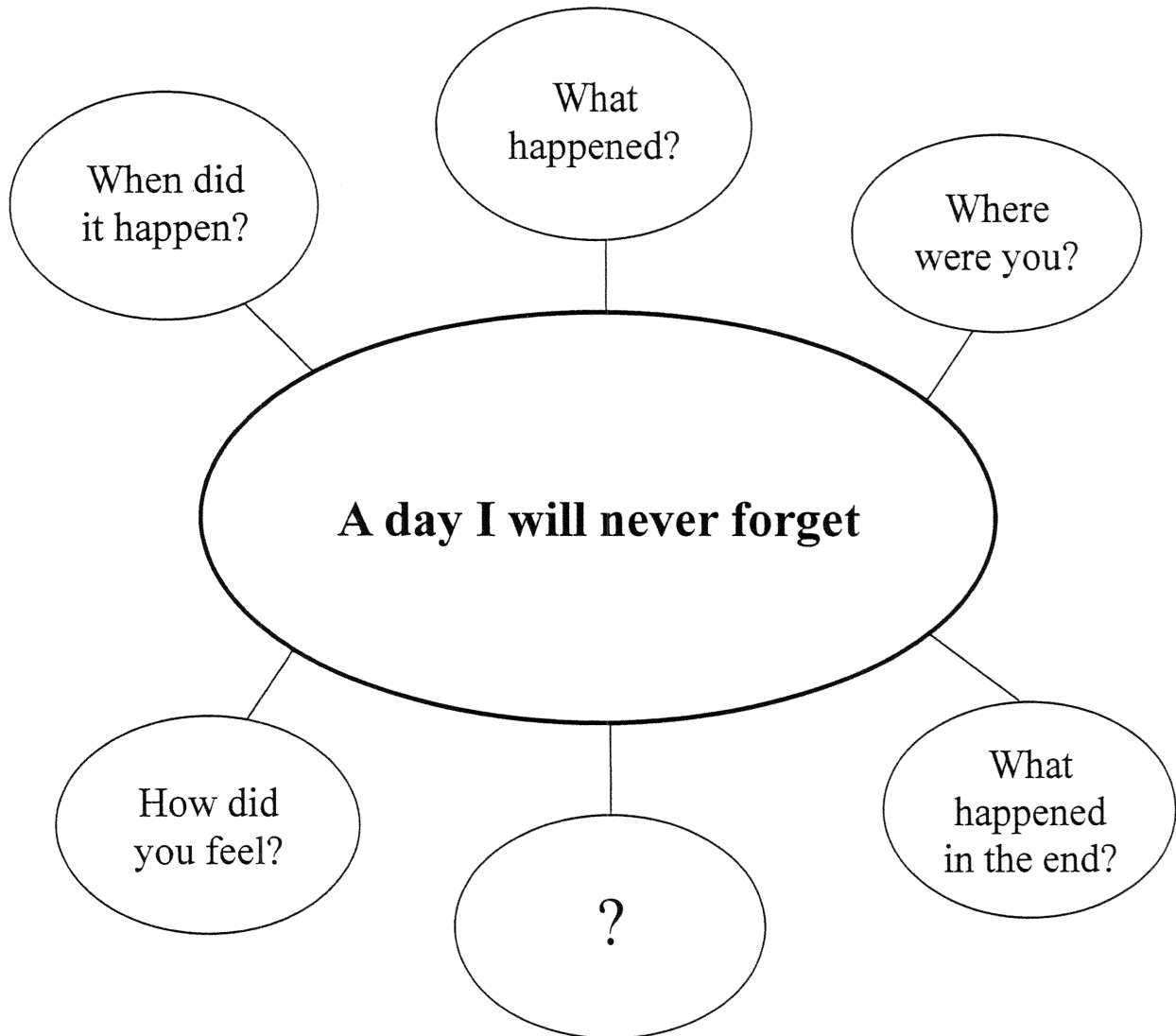
