business.

Polly: Did you stay in the United States?

Grandpa: No, the ship was going to America but it stopped off in Canada. I had an uncle

Canada.

Polly: Grandpa, what is a ranch?

Grandpa: It's like a large farm where cowboys keep their cattle. Many of them have

animals like cows and horses on their land.

Polly: What did you do there?

Grandpa: I took care of a large herd of cattle. I thought it would be exciting to learn how to

be a cowboy.

Polly: Yeah, that does sound exciting! Did you have to carry a gun?

Grandpa: Oh, yes. We had to carry a gun in case wild animals attacked us.

Polly: Did people use their guns to shoot other people?

Grandpa: Yes, I'm afraid there were a few bad people who did. They used guns to rob

others. They were thieves, not cowboys.
