

**Presentation Mark: (1) Mathematical expression(s) is/are correct, but wrong answer given, award the Presentation Mark.
 (2) Mathematical expression(s) is/are incorrect, do not award the Presentation Mark.
 (3) Presentation mark includes holistic assessment of mathematical expression(s), units (missing unit or wrong unit), explanation, statement/conclusion and use of symbols(including the equal sign), etc.
