Narrator: Part 3

Ms Wong:

The three kept walking but it became darker and colder.

Peter said, "My legs are so tired and I'm shaking from the cold."

Alan said, "Don't worry, Peter. I'm sure that this main path will lead us to the road and a bus stop."

The three walked on. They came to a side path. It went downhill. It seemed to go all the way down.

Peter said, "I want to take this side path."

Mary replied, "Oh no! Peter (worried tone). We must stay together on the main path."

Peter said, "You two go ahead. I'm taking this side path down."

pause)

Alan and Mary wished Peter good luck and continued walking along the main path. Peter went off by himself. Peter was very foolish. It is never a good idea to walk alone in the countryside.

Can you guess what happened? The main path soon went downhill and Alan and Mary found a road and a bus stop within an hour. The side path only went downhill a short way and then uphill. Peter walked on and on alone. However, he was very lucky. After an hour, he ran into another group of hikers who knew the way to the road.]
