Narrator: No. 3: How did Peter feel? (beep) (8-second pause)

No. 4: Who saw Peter in the playground? (beep) (8-second pause)

You now have 5 seconds to read Questions 5 and 6. (5-second music) Listen to

the last part of the story.

Miss Lee: "Don't worry, Peter," Jenny said, "I have two sandwiches. I can give you one." He

ate the sandwich. "Thank you very much, Jenny," Peter said, "I'm so happy now.

I'm not hungry anymore."]

Narrator: No. 5: How did Peter's friend help him? (beep) (8-second pause)

No. 6: Why was Peter happy at the end of the story? (beep) (8-second pause)

Listen to the story again and check your answers. The story will begin now.

Repeat [] without pauses and questions.
