Narrator:	Part 2 Miss Chan, Susan's teacher, is talking to her class.
	Listen to what Miss Chan says. The conversation will be played two times. When you hear a beep (<i>beep</i>), answer the question. You now have 15 seconds to read the questions (<i>15-second music</i>). The conversation will begin now.
Miss Chan:	C Good morning students. Next Friday, we will go on our school picnic. I'm going to tell you what you need to bring. Also, I'll tell you how to behave in the park. Please listen carefully. <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i>
Susan:	Wow! School picnic? Where are we going for the picnic?
Miss Chan:	Joy Park in Sai Kung. //(beep)(8-second pause)
Ben:	Should we come to school early on our picnic day?
Miss Chan:	Come to school at 7:45 on Friday. We'll leave school for the park at 8:15. Don't be late. <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i> Do not wear school uniform. Wear your P.E. clothes. <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i> Please also bring a hat and an umbrella. It may be sunny or rainy on that day. <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i>
Susan:	How can we get to the park?
Miss Chan:	We will go by school bus. Our class will go on Bus Number 15. <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i>
Ben:	What are we going to do on that day?
Miss Chan:	We'll play badminton. However, please don't bring computer games and playing cards. Cycling is also not allowed. <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i>
Ben:	Oh, no! No computer games. (<i>disappointed and sad tone</i>) //(<i>beep</i>)(8-second pause)
Susan:	Can I bring my camera? I want to take photos of the beautiful flowers.
Miss Chan:	Sure, Susan. Take photos if you wish. //(beep)(8-second pause)

Ben: What can we eat for lunch, Miss Chan?

- Miss Chan: Bring your own lunch. You can also bring some snacks like fruit and cakes. Do not bring junk food like potato chips and chocolate bars. You should bring a bottle of water to drink. *II(beep)(8-second pause)*
- Miss Chan: Now, children, I want you to remember one very important thing. Do not leave any litter on the ground. Put all your rubbish into litter bins. Can you do that?
- Class: Yes, sure.] (happy voice) //(beep)(8-second pause)
- Narrator: Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The conversation will begin now.

Repeat [] without pauses.
