

** Presentation Mark:

- (1) Mathematical expressions correct but wrong answer given, award the presentation mark as appropriate.
- (2) Mathematical expressions incorrect, do not award the presentation mark.
- (3) Presentation mark includes holistic assessment of mathematical expressions, units (missing or wrong units), explanation, statement/conclusion and use of symbols including the equal sign, etc.
