yummy. //(beep)(8-second pause)

Mum: I know. But they're very expensive.

Tom: You still have some coupons from the supermarket.

Mum: I used all the \$50 coupons two days ago. I only have one \$100 coupon left.

Tom: Please, Mum.

Mum: Okay. //(beep)(8-second pause)

Tom: Can we go to the supermarket near my school? That one is bigger.

Mum: Where is it?

Tom: It's on King Billy Street. //(beep)(8-second pause)

Mum: When can you leave school today?

Tom: At 3:30. Oh, no...I have music practice up to 4:15.

Mum: I leave my office at 3:50 so let's meet at 4:30 at the supermarket. //(beep)(16- second

pause)

Tom, write down my new telephone number. It's 40378442. You can call me when

you get there. //(beep)(8-second pause)

Tom: Okay. It's time for school. See you, Mum.

Mum: See you, Tom.]

Narrator: Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The conversation will

begin now.

Repeat [] without pauses.
