Narrator:	Question 4. What does Charlie read in the newspaper? <i>ll(beep)(8-second pause)</i> Question 5. What does Charlie think of the story? <i>ll (beep)(8-second pause)</i>
	You now have 5 seconds to read Questions 6 to 7. (5-second music) Listen to the third part of the story.
Mum:	Charlie thinks about his bad day. His baby brother broke his toy car. He looks at his other toys on the shelf. He can see a robot, a ball and a train. He does not want to play with them. He only wants to play with his toy car.
Narrator:	Question 6. Why does Charlie think he has a bad day? <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i> Question 7. Which toy does Charlie want to play with? <i>//(beep)(8-second pause)</i>
	You now have 5 seconds to read Question 8. (5-second music) Listen to the fourth part of the story.
