Tom: How do you keep fit?

Uncle John: By running. I run 4 kilometres each day. //(beep)(8-second pause)

Tom: Do you like your work?

Uncle John: Yes, I like it very much. When I put out fires, I feel great! (happy tone)

//(beep)(8-second pause)

Tom: Do you have to work long hours?

Uncle John: Yes, I work 24 hours.

Tom: Wow! 24 hours! (surprised)//(beep)(8-second pause)

Tom: I think firemen are hardworking and brave. What do you think?

Uncle John: I think firemen work fast to help people. We can't be slow because fire is

dangerous!] //(beep)(8-second pause)

Narrator: Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The conversation

will begin now.
