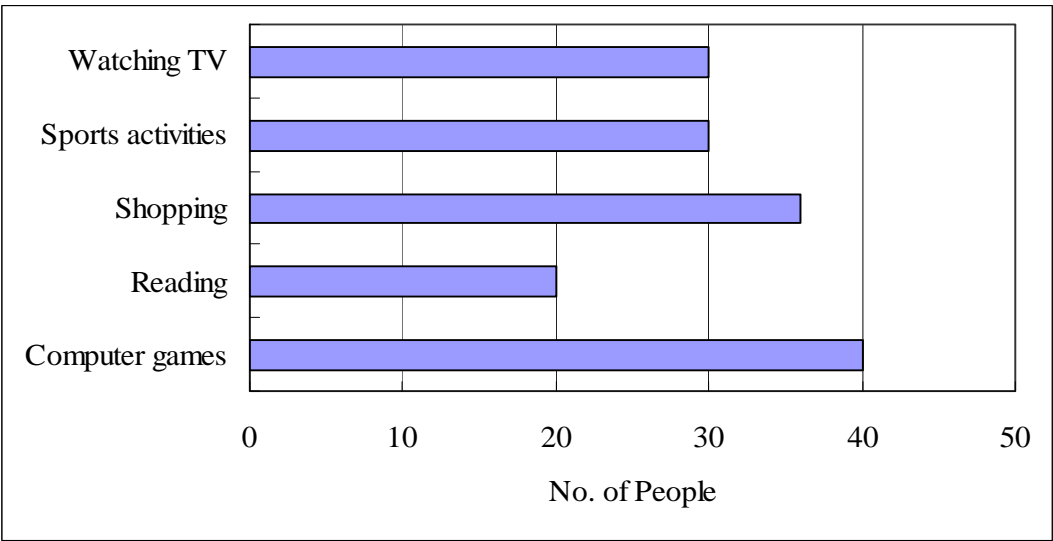


Chart 2: Reasons

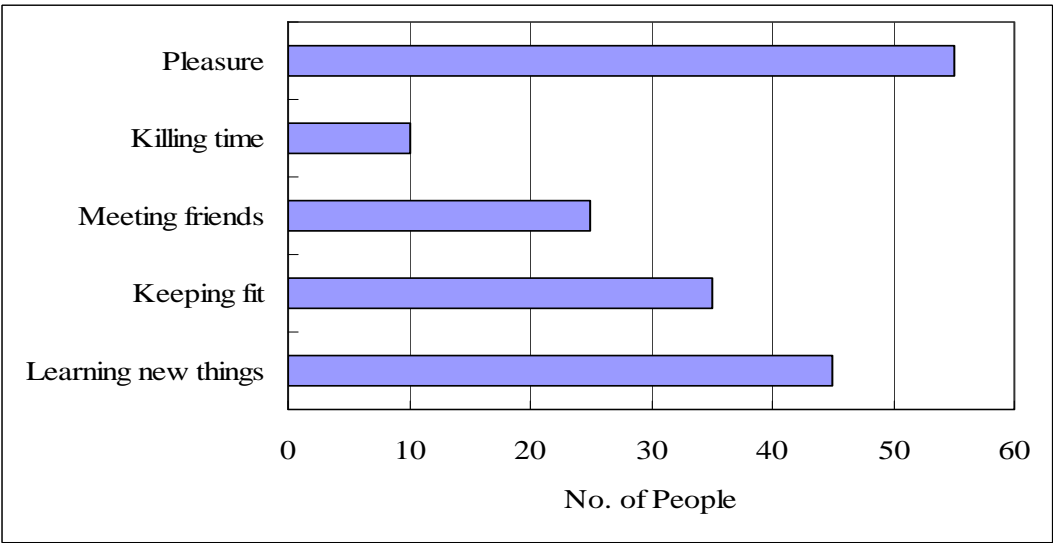


Chart 3: Time spent per week

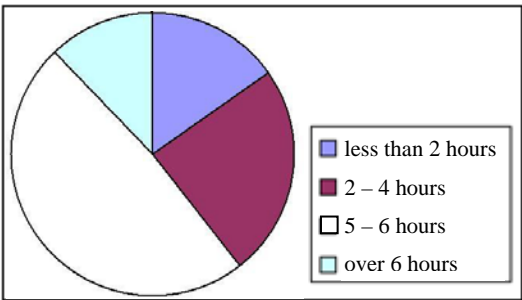
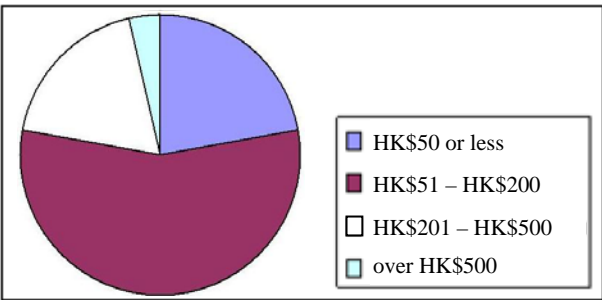


Chart 4: Money spent per week

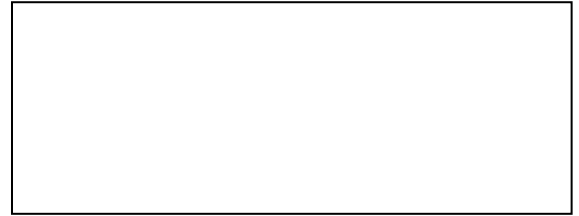

Hall, Central, from 1 April to 20 April, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.

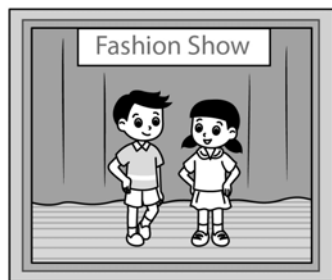
