got the first prize in a drawing competition when he was eight. // (beep)(8-second pause) But I didn't like his paintings because the colours were all brown and black. He drew a lot of poor children in

China. They made me sad. // (beep)(8-second pause)

Dad: Poor children also make me sad.

Judy: When I grow up, I want to be a painter too and help the poor

children in China. I don't have much money but I can give them my

paintings to make them happy.

Dad: I'm sure you can help. // (beep)(8-second pause)

Narrator: Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The

conversation will begin now.
