Grandpa: Oh, that's too bad.

Jenny: But Dad took us to a fast food shop later. Mum ate a hamburger and an

apple pie. I was very hungry so I ate two sandwiches. I also had four

chicken wings! // (beep)(8-second pause)

Grandpa: Wow! You ate a lot! (surprised) // (beep)(8-second pause)

Jenny: Let me show you something. This big seashell is for you, Grandpa. I got it

from the beach.

Grandpa: Oh, it's lovely. It looks like a fan. Thank you, Jenny. // (beep)(8-second

pause)
