John:	Yes, it likes to jump onto the sofa and bite the soft toys we put there.
Jenny:	That's not nice.
John:	No, it's not. But that's its favourite game. My dog looks so cute when it's playing with these toys. (<i>happy tone</i>) // (<i>beep</i>)(8-second pause)
Jenny:	Does it play on your bed?
John:	No, it can't go on my bed. My mum doesn't let it. But she loves my dog because it does everything she orders. // (beep)(8-second pause)
Narrator:	Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The conversation will begin now. Repeat () without pauses. This is the end of Part 1A. (<i>5-second pause</i>)
