Grandpa: Did you play any games?

Lily: Yes. There were puzzles, riddles and matching games. But I liked the

spelling games most. // (beep)(8-second pause)

Grandpa: Which spelling game did you like?

Lily: I liked the game 'Bingo'. // (beep)(8-second pause)

Grandpa: Did you play the games in the classrooms or in the playground?

Lily: I played them in the hall and the computer room. // (beep)(8-second

pause)

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Grandpa: Did you get any prizes?

Lily: Some students got a ruler, a file or a pen. I got a pencil case.

Grandpa: That's good. // (beep)(8-second pause)

Narrator: Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The

conversation will begin now.

Repeat [] without pauses.
