

Narrator: Part 1A

John is doing a survey. He is asking his classmates how they spend time with their family.

You now have 30 seconds to study Questions 1 to 6. (30-second music)

Now, listen to what the students say. The recording will be played \underline{two} times. The recording will begin now.

- Sam: [Hi! I'm Sam. I seldom see my parents. Both of them work and come home very late, often after I have gone to sleep. When I leave for school in the morning, they are still sleeping. We can only spend time together on public holidays such as Chinese New Year and Christmas.
- Narrator: You now have 15 seconds to answer Questions 1 and 2. (beep) (15-second pause)
- May: Hi, my name is May. My parents teach English Language at school and they both like sports very much. When the weather is not so hot, we go hiking in the country parks every weekend. But on hot sunny days in summer, we go to a public pool to swim.
- Narrator: You now have 15 seconds to answer Questions 3 and 4. (beep) (15-second pause)
- Peter: Hi! I'm Peter. On weekdays both my parents are busy at work, so we don't have much time to spend together. But on weekends, it's different. My mum and dad don't work on Saturdays and Sundays. We go for meals in restaurants but don't go shopping because the shops are too crowded.]
- Narrator: You now have 15 seconds to answer Questions 5 and 6. (beep) (15-second pause)

Narrator: Part 3 Susan's teacher, Miss Ho, is telling a story to her class. You now have 55 seconds to study Questions 1 to 11. (55-second music) Now, listen to the story. The story will be played two times. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the question. The story will begin now. Miss Ho: [Good morning, students. Today I'm going to tell you a story. It's about a 12-year-old boy called Billy. He was a very naughty student. He did not like going to school and doing homework. He spent most of his time playing video games and sleeping. However, his father taught him to fish and he liked that. Narrator: Question 1: Which of the following is true about Billy when he was 12 years old? (beep) (8-second pause) One day Billy went fishing alone by the sea. Suddenly a large fish pulled on his Miss Ho: fishing line. Of course, Billy became very excited. He was standing on a wet rock, but he suddenly slipped and fell into the water! Sadly, Billy did not know how to swim and the water was deep. He was in trouble! He cried, <<"Help! Help!">> He was sinking and sinking into deeper water. Question 2: Where did Billy go fishing one day? (beep) (8-second pause) Narrator: Question 3: Why was Billy in trouble? (beep) (8-second pause) Listen to what Billy says again and answer Question 4. Repeat << >> Question 4: How did Billy feel? (beep) (8-second pause) Miss Ho: Just then a man came along. He saw Billy crying for help and went to rescue him. The man found a bamboo stick nearby and held it out to Billy. // He pulled Billy out of the water. Billy's face was as white as a sheet. // The man had saved Billy from drowning. He was a swimming coach. When the swimming coach

found that Billy could not swim, he offered to give him swimming lessons. Of course, Billy agreed at once. The man also told him it was dangerous to fish alone. Billy promised he would not do it again.

 Question 11: The following sentences are about the story. Put them in the correct order. (beep) (8-second pause)
