trouble for forgetting to hand in my homework.

Mark – Student Well, that's just one part of being a parent. I'm sure there are other

things that your mum and dad do for you?

Sally – Student Yes, you're right I guess. Hey, Miss Mack gave us a poem to listen to.

Shall we listen and see if we can get some ideas from it?

Mark – Student Sounds great. Maybe it will give you some ideas about what to write in

your speech about one of your parents.
