





#### Narrator: Part 1A Charles is doing a school project. He is asking his friends about their favourite sports. Now, listen to what they say. The recording will be played two times. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the questions. Now, study Questions 1 and 2. (10-second music) Listen to the first part of the recording. Mary: [ Hi, I'm Mary. I like playing basketball and I'm on the school team. This year we have a smart new uniform. We have practice two times a week. Miss Tong is our coach and she teaches us many skills. But the thing I like most about basketball is the team work. I have three good friends in the team and it's great fun to play with them. Every year, our school enters inter-school competitions and we have come first four times! Narrator: Now, answer Questions 1 and 2. (beep) (15-second pause) Now, study Questions 3 and 4. (10-second music) Listen to the second part of the recording. Jacky: Hi, I'm Jacky. I like running because I don't need to buy anything special, just a pair of sports shoes. The place I often go to is the hills near my home. But I sometimes go to sports grounds and parks. Last week, I went running along the harbour. Mother:	That's okay, Charles.
Charles:	Now, we'll have to fill in our address. Flat D, 15 <sup>th</sup> floor, 28 Harbour Road,
	Sha Tin.
Mother:	And our telephone number?
Charles:	Yes. I've filled it in already.
Mother:	Good. How about the date?
Charles:	Today is the 11 <sup>th</sup> of February. When do you want the food to arrive? One
	pm?






Mother:	No, I'll go out at about one thirty. Put down twelve forty-five.

Now, study Questions 6 and 7. (10-second music) Listen to stanza 3 and answer Questions 6 and 7.



Listen to the poem one more time and check your answers. The poem will begin now.


