
Crazy Race


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

Fried Rice in a Pineapple Boat

Ingredients:

- ◇ 1 pineapple
- ◇ 8 shrimps
- ◇ 2 eggs
- ◇ some peanuts
- ◇ 1 onion
- ◇ $\frac{1}{2}$ chilli
- ◇ 3 bowls of rice

Steps:

1. Cut the pineapple into halves.
2. Take the fruit of the pineapple out with a spoon.
3. Keep half of the hollow pineapple and use it as a bowl.
4. Cut the pineapple fruit into small pieces.
5. Chop the chilli and onion.
6. Beat the eggs, fry them and cut them into thin pieces.
7. Fry the shrimps for 2 minutes.
8. Fry the rice for 5 minutes.
9. Put all the ingredients from Steps 4 to 7 into the rice and mix them well.
10. Fry them for about 10 more minutes until you hear a sizzle.
11. Put the fried rice into the pineapple bowl.
12. Add the peanuts on top.
13. Enjoy the fried rice with your family!


