Narrator: **Part 1A**

Tommy is listening to a news report.

Listen to the news report. The news report will be played **two times**. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the questions.

Now, study Questions 1 and 2. (10-second music)

Listen to the first part of the news report.

Reporter: [Welcome to the evening news. Three hikers were caught in the heavy rain on Tiger Hill yesterday. One was hurt.

Reporter: Next is the weather report. The temperature is now 15 degrees Celsius. Tomorrow's temperature will be between 13 and 18 degrees. There has been heavy rain since yesterday. 21 millimetres of rain has been recorded. The weather will be worse tomorrow.
