Narrator: **Part 1A**

Tommy's new classmates are introducing themselves on their first day of school.

Listen to what they say. The recording will be played **two times**. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the questions.

Now, study Questions 1 to 3. (15-second music)

Listen to the first speech.

Jack: [I'm Jack. I live in a village on Lantau Island near the sea. When I was very small, there were only a few houses and a temple there. So, it was very quiet. Now there are shops, restaurants and a small hotel. But I only like to go to the supermarket. Many tourists go to Lantau Island now. They make a lot of noise and make the beach dirty. I can no longer run around freely on the island.

Narrator: Now, answer Questions 1 to 3. (beep) (20-second pause)

Now, study Questions 4 to 6. (15-second music)

Listen to the second speech.

Susan: My name is Susan. I live on a housing estate. Through the window I can see a busy road. Across the road there is a park. I play basketball there. My grandma does exercise there with other old people too. Next to the park is our school. I know many of you come to school by bus, tram or MTR. But it only takes me five minutes to walk here, so I can have more time to sleep!]

Narrator: Now, answer Questions 4 to 6. (beep) (20-second pause)

Listen to the speeches again and check your answers. The speeches will begin now.

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Narrator: **Part 1B**

Sam and his mother are shopping online.

Listen to what they say. The conversation will be played **two times**. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the questions.

Now, study Questions 1 to 4. (20-second music)

Listen to the first part of the conversation.

Mother: [Sam, come and help me buy some things from Danny Supermarket online.

Sam: Yes, Mum. Here's the website. What do you want to buy, Mum?

Mother: First, some fruit juice.

Sam: Apple, lemon or orange juice?

Mother: Dad's favourite is grape juice. Let's order two cartons for him.

Sam: OK.

Mother: We need some biscuits. How about Tommy's chocolate biscuits?

Sam: I prefer cheese biscuits. Can I order five packs?

Mother: Sure. I also need a tube of toothpaste.

Sam: I need one too, and also a toothbrush.

Mother: Order two of each then. I think that's all.

Sam: The total is two hundred and ten dollars. There is a gift since we have ordered over one hundred and fifty dollars. Which gift do you want, cola, tea, coffee or milk?

Mother: Let's choose the last one.

Sam: OK.

Narrator: Now, answer Questions 1 to 4. (beep) (25-second pause)

Now, study Questions 5 to 7. (15-second music)

Listen to the second part of the conversation.

Sam: Today is the 6th of August. What time do you want the things to arrive? 5pm today?

Mother: How about 4pm? I'll go out at 4:30pm.

Sam: Alright.

Mother: Then put in the customer's name.

Sam: OK. Sam Chan.

Mother: No, put in my name or Dad's name... Ann Ho, Ann without an 'e', or John Chan.

Sam: OK. I'll put in your name.

Mother: Then our address.

Sam: Flat C, 5th floor, 14 Green Road.

Mother: Correct. And our phone number?

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Sam: I've filled it in already. Finished.

Mother: Thanks, Sam.

Sam: You're welcome, Mum.]

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Narrator: **Part 2**

Miss Chan is reading a poem to her class.

Listen to the poem. The poem will be played **three times**. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the question.

Listen to the poem for the first time.

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Narrator: **Part 3**

Miss Luk is telling a story to her students.

Listen to the story. The story will be played **two times**. When you hear a beep (beep), answer the question or questions.

Now, study Questions 1 and 2. (10-second music)

Listen to the first part of the story.

Miss Luk: [Jim's parents both had to go out to work. Dad was very busy so he always came home late. When Mum came back at about 6pm, she did the housework and looked after Jim. Jim was a lazy student. Every day, Mum asked Jim, 'Have you finished your homework?' She helped him with his homework and prepare for tests. Dinner time was at about 8pm. But Jim always kept watching TV. Mum had to tell him to have dinner many times. After dinner, Jim played computer games. At about 10pm, Mum told him to go to bed.

Narrator: Now, answer Questions 1 and 2. (beep) (15-second pause)

Now, study Questions 3 to 5. (15-second music)

Listen to the second part of the story.

Miss Luk: Jim was very unhappy. Mum always told him what to do. He hoped she would disappear one day and leave him alone. One day Mum said she had to work in Tokyo and stay there for a few weeks. Jim said to himself, // 'Am I dreaming? (happy tone) // No one will tell me what to do any more.' < Jim felt like a bird flying in the sky. >

Now, study Questions 6 and 7. (10-second music)

Listen to the third part of the story.

Miss Luk: After Mum left, Jim only had fast food for dinner. Dad had no time to cook. Jim was lazy as usual. He did not study, so he failed his English and Maths tests. He played computer games till midnight. In the morning, no one woke him up. He was always late for school. His teacher punished him and he couldn't join any activities. Some classmates laughed at him. He felt very sad. He was sorry that he hadn't listened to Mum.

Narrator: Now, answer Questions 6 and 7. (beep) (15-second pause)

Now, study Question 8. (8-second music)

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Listen to the last part of the story.

Miss Luk: A month later, Mum came home so Jim was very happy. He said sorry to her. She gave Jim some comic books from Japan. Then she made dinner for the family. That night Jim couldn't stop reading the comic books. At 10pm, Mum came into his bedroom and said, 'Jim, it's time for bed!']

Now, study and answer Questions 9 and 10. (beep) (25-second pause)
Listen to the story again and check your answers. The story will begin now.
